RESPONSIBILITIES & REQUIREMENTS FOR COACH:

1. Enhance the skills and levels of excellence already displayed by bowlers in the 2008 WA Rachuig Teams.
2. Impart a positive attitude towards winning the 2008 National Team events in Canberra, ACT in October 2008.
3. Liaise with the Managers and assist them at all times.
4. Perform other duties related to the coaching and preparation of the WA Rachuig Teams as required by the TBAWA.
5. Support the TBAWA and General Committee at all times, and comply with all lawful instructions as defined in the TBAL "Code of Ethics".
6. Be prepared to conduct regular training of the WA Rachuig Teams at any WA Metropolitan Bowling Centre at times and places agreed with the TBAWA General Committee.
7. Be responsible for and have complete jurisdiction in any matter relating to Team line-ups, bowling or discipline on the lanes.
8. Be at least an experienced TBAL accredited Level 2 Coach and must be able to demonstrate relevant experience in coaching State Teams in Australia.
9. Be available to travel with the Teams to Canberra, ACT in October 2008.
10. Participate in fundraising events run to assist the Team and Team officials. Coaches will be required to meet any personal shortfall if insufficient funds are raised; estimated cost may be as high as \$1900.00 per person, and pay individual invoices by the due dates.
11. Undertake, when required, mentoring, training and encouragement to any Level 1 Coach who may be attached to the Rachuig squad to gain experience.
12. Be prepared to submit a verbal report at TBAWA Committee meetings of activities during training and a written report of preparation and competition to the TBAWA within 14 days of return from the event in Canberra, ACT.
