CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 This tournament is open to all Men and Women, **aged 18 years or over on or prior to the first day of the 2009 TBA Adult Nationals**, registered through a WA Centre Association.
- 2 All Competitors must be permanent residents of Western Australia as at 1 March 2009.
- 3 Qualifying is necessary, except for the Defending Champion. All Qualifying scores are to be submitted with entry form, score sheet and till receipt from the centre, to PO Box 397 GREENWOOD WA 6924, as soon as possible after qualifying completed.
- 4 If qualifying during last two days, phone results to TBAWA Treasurer Bev Pendreigh, 9246 4575, on Mon 18 May 09, as well as submitting form.
- 5 All bowlers must hold a 2009 TBA Bowler Registration Card through a TBA licensed Centre Association at a TBA registered Bowling Centre which must be **produced at check in on the first day**.
- 6 TBA Tournament and General Playing Rules will apply. TBA rules state that non-registered bowlers can not bowl in TBA accredited State events.
- 7 A neat, tidy and acceptable standard of bowling attire is required to bowl in this event. Shirts with another bowler's name on are not to be worn. No jeans, track pants or cargos are allowed.
- 8 The Tournament Director will decide matters not covered by these conditions.

FINAL

The final will be **EITHER** Round 1 cut to Top 7 with the next Rounds using TBA National Masters single elimination **OR** Round 1 cut to Top 4 with the next Round head-to-head round robin. **See format, below**, for details.

COST

Cost of the final will be \$70.00; which will cover Bowling Fees, Prize Fund and Tournament Expenses.

FORMAT OF FINAL

*** If 10 or more entries are received** – Round 1– Top 10 qualifying entrants in both Male and Female Divisions will bowl 4-games in random positions, moving after 2 games, to decide order of seeding. Defending Champion receives a bye.

Round 2 – A maximum of 8 will contest the Final 3-game, TBA single elimination Match Play (Rounds 2, 3 & 4). Best two (2) out of the three (3) games to win the match. The 2008 Defending Champion will be seeded number one and the seven highest qualifiers after the four games will be seeded 2 to 8. Bowlers will compete in format with

Round 3 (Semi final) – The four winners of Round 2 will compete in Round 3.

Round 4 (final) – The two winners of Round 3 will compete in the Final. Winner of this game will be the WA Open Masters Champion.

*** If sufficient entries are NOT received** – Round 1– All qualifying entrants in both Male and Female Divisions will bowl 4-games in random positions, moving after 2 games, to decide cut to Top four (4). Defending Champion receives a bye.

Round 2 – A maximum of 5 will join the defending champion to contest four single game head to head round robin matches with +10 for win and +5 for draw. Bowler with the highest pinfall plus bonus points will be the WA Open Masters Champion.

PRIZE FUND – Male & Female Divisions

If the winner **intends to compete** in TBA Australian Championship (Masters) at Mt Gravatt Bowl, Qld, the prize fund will be:
