Conditions of entry WA Restricted Adult Masters 2009

1. This tournament is open to all **men who have an average not greater than 184 and women who have an average not greater than 174**, aged 18 years or over on or prior to 3 Oct 09, the first day of the 2009 TBA Adult Nationals. Entering average will be the **HIGHEST TBA ACCREDITED LEAGUE AVERAGE as of the 30 April 2009** provided that 21 games have been bowled.
2. All contestants must be permanent residents of Western Australia as at 1 May 2009.
3. Qualifying is not necessary. Bowlers may express their wish to bowl by **mailing their entry form** to WA Restricted Adult Masters, PO Box 397, Greenwood WA 6924 postmarked by Tuesday 2 June 2009. This will ensure a place in the event and assist with tournament administration. TD can accept entries on the day.
4. Every Bowler will be required to bowl 6 games. Entering average plus first three games used to calculate handicap to be used for all the six games. Placing's will be determined by total pinfall plus handicap over these six games. Should there be a tie for first or second place, score plus handicap of a one game roll off will determine the placing.
5. All bowlers must hold a 2009 TBA Bowler Registration Card through a TBA licensed Centre Association at a TBA registered Bowling Centre, **proof of which must be produced at check in.**
6. A neat, tidy and acceptable standard of bowling attire is required to bowl in this event. Shirts with another bowler's name on are not to be worn. No jeans, track pants or cargos are allowed.
7. The Tournament Director will decide matters not covered by these rules. All TBA Tournament Rules, Regulations and general bowling rules will apply.

COST

Cost to bowl in the event is \$60.00; which will cover bowling fees, tournament expenses and the event prize fund.

EVENT PRIZE FUND – Male & Female Divisions

If the winner **intends to compete** in TBA Australian Restricted Cup at Mt Gravatt, Qld in October 09 the prize fund will be:

- 1st Place 100 % of available event prize money
- WA Restricted Adult Masters Shirt
- Paid entry into the 2009 TBA Australian Restricted Cup

The prize money is payable on confirmation of participation in the 2009 TBA Australian Restricted Cup at Mt Gravatt to represent WA on 8 October 2009. Travel will be at the expense of the winner, who will also need to bowl in All-Events at the TBA Nationals in Mt Gravatt to be eligible to represent WA in the Finals of the Australian Restricted Cup.

If the winner **decides not to compete** in Mt Gravatt, the event prize fund will be on the basis of one prize for every ten entries:-

- 1st Place 65% of available prize money
- W.A. Restricted Adult Masters Shirt
- 2nd Place 35% of available prize money

SPECIAL PRIZE FUND – Male & Female Divisions

In addition, separate from the event prize fund, incentive prizes of **\$100 for 1st** and **\$60 for 2nd** will be paid on the day. The special prize fund has been organised to encourage ALL eligible bowlers to compete in a regional centre for this 2009 State Event.
