**General Rules & Information (See also Specific Rules)**

1. This is a TBAWA tournament and all TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply. All bowlers participating in these championships must be registered with TBA for 2009 as a Member, and bowl in a league at a TBA registered Western Australian bowling centre. **TBA Registration Cards must be produced at Check-in.**
2. **ADVANCE ENTRIES** and **Centre Champion's** entries close **Fri 21 August, 2009**. Each entry must be competed **in full, with name, adult/junior/disability, average and grade**. Weekend Squads have limited numbers **so book by Advance Entry date** to avoid disappointment. **Late entries and weekday/night entries accepted**, subject to lane availability, by contacting Control Staff at Joondalup Bowl on 9300 1311. If average and grade not filled in, then person, doubles or team will be put in Open grade.
3. **ENTERING AVERAGES** A bowler's entering average for Singles will determine the Grade for "All Events". The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-grade any bowler prior to, or after the commencement of play. Submitting an incorrect average may result in disqualification. By entering, bowler agrees that centre may be contacted for average verification.
4. **"ALL EVENTS"** Champion will be declared for each Grade for which a paid All Events entry is received. Scores from each bowler's **BEST** eligible appearance in any Team or Mixed Team, Doubles or Mixed Doubles and Singles will count towards their "All Event" total. Eligibility for **"All Events"** is subject to the completion of **"All Events" entry form and \$5 payment BEFORE THE FIRST EVENT IS BOWLED.**
5. **GRADING** will be based on the entering averages submitted, and allocated in accordance with the Adult, Junior and Disability **Grading Table**. Otherwise **bowlers will be entered in OPEN GRADE.**
6. **SMOKING OR CONSUMING ALCOHOL** is **prohibited** during a session of continuous games during the Championships.
7. **DRESS STANDARDS** for all competitors must be neat and tidy. **No tank tops, denim, track or cargo pants, jeans** or a shirt bearing another bowler's name will be allowed. Shirts may display a sponsor's name. The Tournament Director reserves the right to **postpone or disqualify any bowler not attired correctly.**
8. **PROTESTS** must be stated verbally to the Tournament Director or designated person, within 15 minutes of the infraction having occurred. The protest must also be lodged in writing to the Tournament Director or representative, within one (1) hour of completion of play of the squad in which the incident occurred.
9. **VERBAL AND/OR PHYSICAL ABUSE** of any person or item of equipment will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification. No bowler, in any grade, division or classification will be exempt from abiding by the **TBA National Code of Ethics.**
10. **TIES / TIED POSITIONS** will stand, and prizes will be shared.
11. **A THREE (3) GAME** series will be bowled by all bowlers in all Grades and Divisions.
12. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION** will be as follows:
  - a. **TEAMS:** Bowlers may participate in a maximum of four team entries.  
The same four (4) bowlers can only participate twice in the same team.
  - b. **DOUBLES:** Maximum of four entries with the same or a different partner.
  - c. **SINGLES:** Maximum of four entries in their grade or any other grade above their own classification
13. **CENTRE CHAMPIONS.** All Centre Champions will automatically be entered into the corresponding grade and division of these championships. There will be no refunds to bowlers who do not wish to participate in this event. **Each Centre Champion's entries and details must be received by the Advance closing date of Fri 21 August, 2009.**

**Specific Rules – Adults & Juniors**

1. **ENTERING AVERAGES** will be the highest league average as at 30 June 2009, provided a minimum of 18 league games have been bowled prior to that date.
2. **"ALL EVENTS"** Champion for each Adult and Junior Grade for which a paid "All Events" entry is received will receive "All Events" shirt as well as prize money.
3. **TEAMS** for Adult and Junior participation are made up of 4-persons.
4. **ADULT AND JUNIOR GRADING** will be allocated in accordance with the following separate **Adult and Junior Grading Tables:**

- JUNIOR DIVISION** is open to all Junior Bowlers who have not reached the age of 18 as at 1 January 2009. Proof of age may be required. **Juniors may bowl as a member of Adult Division** teams and doubles, but Junior scores in adult events will not count towards Junior “All Events”. Junior Doubles and Junior Teams must be made up entirely of Junior Bowlers to count **in Junior Division “All Events”**.
- Cash prizes** will be calculated in accordance with the TBA prize fund payoff chart, depending on number of entries in the grade.

## Specific Rules – Disabilities

- A BOWLER WITH A DISABILITY** is a registered member of Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd and whose condition is acknowledged by one of the following National Sporting Organisations for People with a Disability being: Ausrapid; Special Olympics Australia; Australian Sports Organisation for the Disabled; Cerebral Palsy Sports and Recreation Federation of Australia; Wheelchair Sports Australia; Australian Blind Sports Federation; Transplant Australia and Deaf Sports Australia and/or their equivalent State bodies.
- ENTERING AVERAGES** will be the highest league, tournament or event average as at 30 June 2009.
- “All EVENTS”** Champion for each Disability Grade, for which a paid All Events entry is received, will receive “All Events” shirt as well as prize money.
- TEAMS** for Disability participation are made up of 4-persons
- DISABILITY GRADING** will be allocated in accordance with the following **Disability Grading Table**:
