TBAWA INTERLEAGUE 2009 RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1 **ELIGIBILITY** - This TBAWA tournament is open to all Male, Female, Adult or Junior TBA registered members who bowl in leagues in TBA registered bowling centres. Each league may enter as many teams as they wish however, individual members may only bowl in one team regardless of how many leagues or Centres in which they bowl. The Teams may be one sex or any combination of male/female/adult/junior.
- 2 **TBA REGISTRATION** – Each bowler is required to show a 2009 TBA Membership Registration card or proof of payment, before bowling. Any team with a non-registered bowler will be disqualified. New registrations accepted prior to qualifying bowling.
- 3 **ENTERING AVERAGES** – Bowlers must use their highest league average as at 30 September 2009, in a TBA accredited league provided 18 games have been bowled. Where a bowler does not have an acceptable accredited league average, the Tournament Director may assign an average from league information provided in the entry form, subject to verification. By entering, the bowler agrees that a centre may be contacted for average verification.
- 4 **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** – A team may have multiple entries, but they must be the same four Bowlers as per their First Entry. (See also 10.1 qualifying). Highest score only to count.
- 5 **All TBA tournament rules and regulations** will apply. Any matters which may arise during qualifying that are not covered by these conditions will be decided by the centre tournament directors, in consultation with TBAWA. Matters during the final will be decided by the tournament director.
- 6 **TEAMS** – Teams will comprise any combination of FOUR Bowlers from the same league.
- 7 **HANDICAP** – This tournament is a handicap event based on 80% of 200.
- 8 **DRESS CODE** for this prestigious event. **QUALIFYING** – A neat and tidy standard of dress is required. **FINALS – NO T-SHIRTS, TRACK PANTS, CARGO or JEANS/DENIM. It is the responsibility of the Team Captain to ensure ALL Team Members are aware of this rule.**
- 9 **NO SMOKING, ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION or MOBILE PHONES DURING THIS TOURNAMENT.**
- 10 **SUBSTITUTES**
 - 10.1 **Qualifying** - Substitutes may be used by any team in their first line-up provided the substitute is a registered player and bowls in the same league which the team is representing and has not bowled in another team during the qualifying. The Substitute and remaining team members become the original First Entry team for the purpose of multiple entries. If a Bowler bowls in more than one team, the score will be replaced in the second and each subsequent entry for that Bowler with a vacancy score of 150 with no handicap. **NO SUBSTITUTES PERMITTED ON MULTIPLE ENTRIES.** Centre Tournament officials **MUST** be notified 15 minutes before squad time of any substitutions.
 - 10.2 **Final** - Any substitute must bowl in the same league the team is representing. **BLIND SCORES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
- 11 **BOWLING FORMAT**
 - 11.1 **Qualifying** - Bowlers will bowl a **three game (3)** series total pinfall plus handicap, as members of a team from any league within any registered Centre.

- 11.1.1** The team with the highest pinfall plus handicap, in each Centre will be the Centre Champion Team and will automatically gain a place in the Final except for rule **11.1.2**. Each Centre or Centre Association is requested to pay the fees for its Centre Champion Team in the Final.
- 11.1.2** If any Centres or Centre Association wish to run a mini tournament in their Centre, to determine the Centre Champion team, the highest team in that tournament will be deemed the winner. Other individual team entries will be accepted from teams that qualify in that Centre outside of the Centre's mini tournament date, but will be in the second group of the qualifying field defined in rule **11.1.3**.
- 11.1.3** The balance of the field for the Final, after notified centre champions, will be the Teams, from any Centre, in order of total pinfall plus handicap. Should any Centre not field teams as per rules **11.1.1** or **11.1.2** the next highest will be used until the Final field is 30 teams.
- 11.2 Final-** Bowlers will bowl a **four (4) game** series total pinfall plus handicap. Highest pinfall plus handicap will determine the 2009 TBAWA Interleague Champion Team.
- 12** A list of the 30 finalists will be emailed to each Centre by Monday 9 November. The Centre should post the list on a Notice Board and it is the Team responsibility to determine if they have made the Final.
- 13** Thirty (30) teams will compete in the 4-game **final at Joondalup on Sunday 15 November 2009**, report time by 9.00 am to bowl at 9:30 am.
- 14** Teams will draw Lanes for the final and will bowl their **four games in two game blocks**, moving lanes after the first 2-game block. Teams will move odd to left and even to right.
- 15** The 31st placed team in the qualifying will be the first reserve for the final. If **not all Bowlers in a finalist team are** checked in by 9.00 am, the reserve team will replace the incomplete team.
- 16 COST**
- 16.1 Qualifying** - \$6 prize fund/tournament expense per player (\$24 per Team) **plus Centre lineage** cost. Centre/Centre Association should forward the qualifying expense to TBAWA by 6 November 2009.
- 16.2 Final** - \$27 per player (\$108 per team) is payable by each Team at check in (Centre Champions should be pre-paid by the Centre/Centre Association).
- 17 TIES**
- 17.1 Qualifying** - Ties for first place in Centre qualifying and 30th place overall will be decided by their highest scoring team game with handicap.
- 17.2 Final** – A tie for first place in the final will be decided by a 9th and 10th frame roll off. All other tied team scores in the final will share the prize money.
- 18** All entry forms to be faxed immediately qualifying is completed to Joondalup, Attn Carol or at the latest by 10pm Monday 3 November 2009. [Joondalup Fax 9300 2566] and **then posted with score sheet completed** to **Interleague TBAWA PO Box 397, GREENWOOD WA 6924** Closing date for receiving qualifying mail is Friday 6 November.
