TENPIN BOWLING ASSOCIATION OF WA

FORMAT:

1. Nominees will bowl in a **12 game roll off** over two (2) days in two (2) centres.
2. Men and Ladies participating in the Trials will compete in a four-person team format where possible.

DRESS CODE FOR TRIALS:

3. Clothing to be of neat and tidy appearance. Men must wear long trousers but no shorts, denim, track pants or cargo pants. Ladies may wear skirts, skorts, suitable shorts or $\frac{3}{4}$ pants. All bowlers must wear a recognised bowling shirt but no tank tops, or shirts that display another person's name allowed.
4. If there is a query on the dress code, please contact a Tournament Director.

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

5. Must hold a 2009 TBA Bowler Registration Card through a TBA licensed Centre Association at a TBA registered Bowling Centre. Show card, or evidence of payment, prior to bowling on Day 1.
6. Must be in good standing and attained the age of 18 years on or prior to the first day of the 2009 TBA National Adult Championships (3 October 2009).
7. Nominees must have competed for at least eight (8) weeks and bowled a minimum of 24 games in a **TBA accredited league** in Western Australia between Jan and Oct 09. Pre or post bowling does not count towards the number of league games bowled.
8. All bowlers nominating must be residents of Western Australia from the commencement of the trials unless granted exemption under TBA Rule 6(f).
9. The TBAWA General Committee reserves the right to reject the nomination of any bowler.
10. Nominations will not be accepted by any bowler who is un-financial with any local or inter-state Associations, Teams or Leagues.

SELECTION:

11. The seven (7) persons making up each of the Mens and Ladies 2009 WA Rachuig Teams will be the top five (5) with highest pinfall after Day 2 plus two (2) selected from those who participate fully in the trials. The next two highest, non-selected persons will be invited to join the Rachuig Training Squad as reserves.
12. The selection panel for each team will be the Coach and the Manager, with the TBAWA Executive and Development Officer.

MEDICAL ARRANGEMENTS

13. Team members who have a pre-existing or on-going illness or infirmity must supply a Medical Certificate (at bowler's expense) in order to participate in the preparation and training of the Teams.
14. Any Team member injured or suffering from a previous injury prior to the Teams departure will be required to furnish a Medical Certificate (at own expense) to prove their fitness to travel.
15. Failure to produce any certificate within one week, or other specified time, will render the bowler liable to be replaced

NOMINATION COMMITMENT DETAILS:

All **bowlers nominating** for the 2009 WA Rachuig Team Selection trials do so by their nomination and signing of the form, **agree to accept the following conditions:**

- 16 Submit a completed 2009 TBAWA Nomination form, together with \$80.00 nomination deposit. (Please note the deposit paid for the Trials is not part of the Team commitment fees.)
- 17 A bowler who fails to complete any stage of the Trials will not be entitled to a refund of any money paid.
- 18 **Enter** at own expense the **Qualifying** for the **TBAWA Open Masters**.
- 19 **Enter** at own expense the **2009 TBAWA State Championships** and complete an **All Events** entry. Failure to comply may result in the removal of the bowler from the WA Team. Bowlers wishing exemption from this requirement must apply in writing to the

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TBAWA General Committee prior to the closing date for the TBAWA State Championships to seek an exemption, for review by the General Committee on an individual basis. Exemptions will be granted for debilitating injuries or illness (upon production of a medical certificate).

- 20 **Enter** at own expense and complete an **All Events** entry in the **2009 TBA National Adult Championships** in Mt Gravatt, Queensland.
- 21 **To attend all meetings, training sessions and TBAWA/other events** as specified by the Coach/Manager, as a priority, **regardless of any bowling, work or other commitments**, unless pre-arranged with the Coach/Manager.
- 22 Team Members are encouraged to participate in fundraising activities. If they do not they will be required to pay the equivalent sum to cover such costs as the other Team Members have raised at that time.
- 23 The estimated amount payable by each Bowler and Team Official is \$2,000 but team fundraising and sponsorships could reduce this amount. A receipt is issued for all money paid.
 - \$600 is payable by top five and on selection (after completion of roll-off, 19 April)
 - \$500 is payable by Sunday 24 May
 - \$500 is payable by Sunday 28 June
 - \$400 is payable by Sunday 19 JulyAny outstanding balance or additional amount due is payable by Sunday 30 August 2009
- The Team Manager will advise the date the team is to travel. If air fare is not arranged and paid for by the individual, payment must be made to the Manager on 19 April 09
- 24 Any bowler who withdraws from a Team prior to 1 August 2009 will only be entitled to a refund of personal contributions made (less purchase price of airfare). No fundraising money refunded to an individual. A Team-member who withdraws from a Team on or after 1 August 2009 will not be entitled to any refund of any money paid up to then.
- 25 Should a vacancy become available in the team, the Selection Panel will choose a suitable replacement from bowlers who competed in the trials.
- 26 Whilst travelling as a Team, Team Members must understand that their commitment is to the Western Australian Team and the performance of the team as a whole.
- 27 The TBAWA General Committee, in consultation with the TD, will decide any matter not resolved by the Tournament Director and such decision will be final.

UNIFORMS AND OTHER ARRANGEMENTS AT HOME AND AWAY:

- 28 Each Team Member will receive a uniform consisting of one (1) or two (2) Team shirts, one jacket (if required) and one training shirt. The cost of the uniform will depend on each individual and will be calculated accordingly.
- 29 Team Members agree to wear the official uniform when required by TBAWA.
- 30 TBAWA Rachuig Committee will arrange and co-ordinate travel and accommodation details for Teams competing in the 2009 TBA National Championships, Rachuig Tournament and Masters in Mt Gravatt, Qld.
- 31 **All Team Members are required to travel with the team and will stay, for the entire period**, at accommodation provided during the number of days attending the TBA Nationals events, the Rachuig Tournament and the Australian Masters.
- 32 Team Members must follow the directives given by Team Managers and Team Coaches at all times. The aims and objectives of the Team as a whole will not be jeopardised through the acts of individuals.
- 33 Team officials will decide if a team Captain is appointed and whom that will be. TBAWA will ratify appointment prior to any announcement of Captain.
- 34 Failure by any Team Member to adhere to the Code of Conduct will result in their removal and departure from the Team at **their own expense**.
